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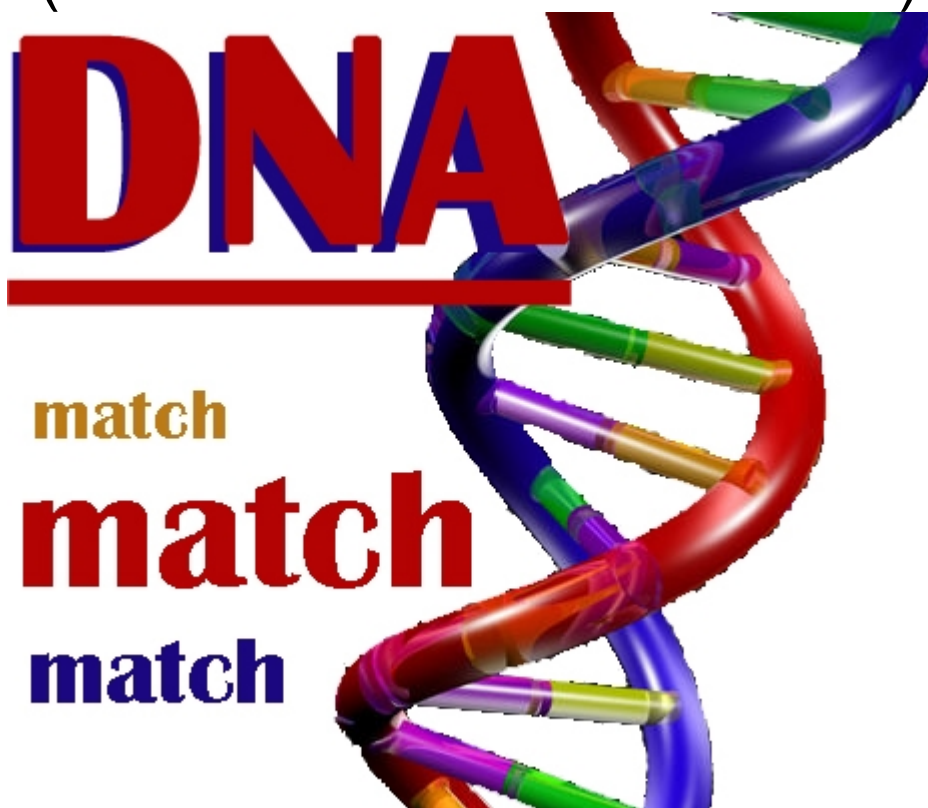
Pedigree Chart for "Petters-Bond" Hans Gudmundsson (ppp.aaaa.05)

Remembering context has been a problem with me for many years now, so have developed a coding system for genealogical context while I am working on projects.

Lettering prefix begins at my parents (#02 for RaMon & JackieAnn). There are two options; First letter is either “p” for my father’s Petrin side, of “f” for mother’s Frey side.

Generation #03 has each grandparent, so there involves 4 possibilities:

pp= Petrin >> Petrin; or

pm= Petrin >> Michaelis; or

ff= Frey >> Frey; or

fs= Frey >> Spencer.

Generation #04 has 16 options, and until recently that was where the prefix ended. Many of the numbers are still set with the old format. But with my dementia symptoms worsening I needed more boost on remembering what branch I was working on, so added a dash and 3 more place-brackets before period, allowing 6 total generations in prefix (and 1024 options with major branches).

Since our culture follows the paternal line, this prefix allows the paternal line to retain basically the same ID#, only changing the generational designation. This is especially important in my Swedish line, where the paternal surname does not follow thru the generations. It is important to note that some tribal cultures (such as Celtic and some Native Americans) were Maternal cultures, where primary family association followed the mother’s line instead of the father’s. Jewish genealogy is somewhat that way in that Jewish nationality follows only thru birth from the mother – your father’s nationality is inconsequential and unless your mother was a Jew you are not considered a Jew.

After prefix is much more complicated. I must have chart to follow, so chart is attached here. Generations 05-10 are these letters followed by “aaa” (unless sibling which is last letter of coding).

Generations 11-15 begin with the letter assigned to family in earlier generations, then appropriate letter (as assigned on chart) as second letter, followed by “aa” (unless sibling).

Generations 16-20 begin with the first two letters assigned to family in earlier generations, then appropriate letter (as assigned on chart) as third letter, followed by “a” (unless sibling).

Recently began adding more letters for generations above 20. Previous numbering system was different – now forgotten, and that is why I simplified by just adding more letters as needed.

Most of the over-20 generations are still with the old numbering system and need to be changed.

– except that if last letter before number of generations is other than “a”, then it is a sibling to my direct ancestor. If “a” is last letter before number of generations, then it is direct ancestor (unless there are other letters AFTER generational number, which indicates that person’s relationship to direct ancestor and can follow down a number of generations. Began this in order to connect those with whom I share match on dna. Coding is: “s” = spouse, then abc first generation of children. Next abc would be relationships in the next generation down (children of the prior generation)

ie: Person “xyz.17a” would be first child born from ancestor xyz.17 (who is 16 generations from me as 01, and 17 generations from my children as generation 00).

Person “xyz.17aa” would be firstborn from firstborn of ancestor “xyz.17”.

?= Exclamation mark before number of generations means theory has been well confirmed.
?= Question mark means very much theory. But some of the tree was before I even got to that point in numbering. If has no number then for sure I have not really even looked at theory yet. If has no “notes” section attached or in media, then have not really looked at theory yet. If on Spencer line (fss) then theory is probably from Brent Ruesch (spouse is one of Ron Spencer’s daughters) and the line goes into 1100s but he spends much time at the national repository in Utah; lives within blocks of it. I think I removed most of both Spencer theory and Pate theory (ffp). But I could have missed some, and actually most genealogy is pretty much theory; some theories are more certain than others – but still theory until confirmed from dna. The ancient stuff added later is somewhat reliable, being from either Burkes’ (John Burke’s work from 1826 has become the definitive guide to the genealogy and heraldry of the Peerage) or the national experts in Pate genealogy (AJ Pate emailed me personally with copies of several research documents he has finished). More reliable info from my membership in Spencer Historical and Genealogical society, but have not got it added yet. Pate (ffp) and Spencer (fss) are the two longest lines known at present.

Generational #: For ancestors, the last two digits of ID# are how many generations from my own children that ancestor is. Spencer Ramon Petrin, Belinda, Michelle, Julie, Debbie, DonnaKay, Renona and Renae are #01.

Expectations: I am at far border of my ability to work on this project. My iq is still above average, and I still have good ability to pull a lot of valuable detail from EACH piece I come across, but I can no longer hold the data from one paragraph of my notes to the next paragraph, in order to integrate the different pieces into usable theories or conclusions. An example was that I was stuck at fss-SS.aaaa!07 Jonathan William Spencer for 3 yrs; had pages of data – but in 2013 I quit being able to reach conclusions if decision required more than 1 or 2 key pieces. I cannot remember elements long enough to synthesize.

So I dropped genealogy for 3yrs and only picked it up beginning of 2016. Making one last push during 2016 to pull together my years of work into something that can be picked up in some future generation when there is enough interest for someone in the family to pursue genealogy.

My goal in Patriot Binders: Hoping to build interest in genealogy and greater understanding of the different perspectives.

Color: Four colors are assigned to the various branches of my own family. I use these colors to find what I am looking for easier. Folders and primary profile pages, etc, usually have these colors:

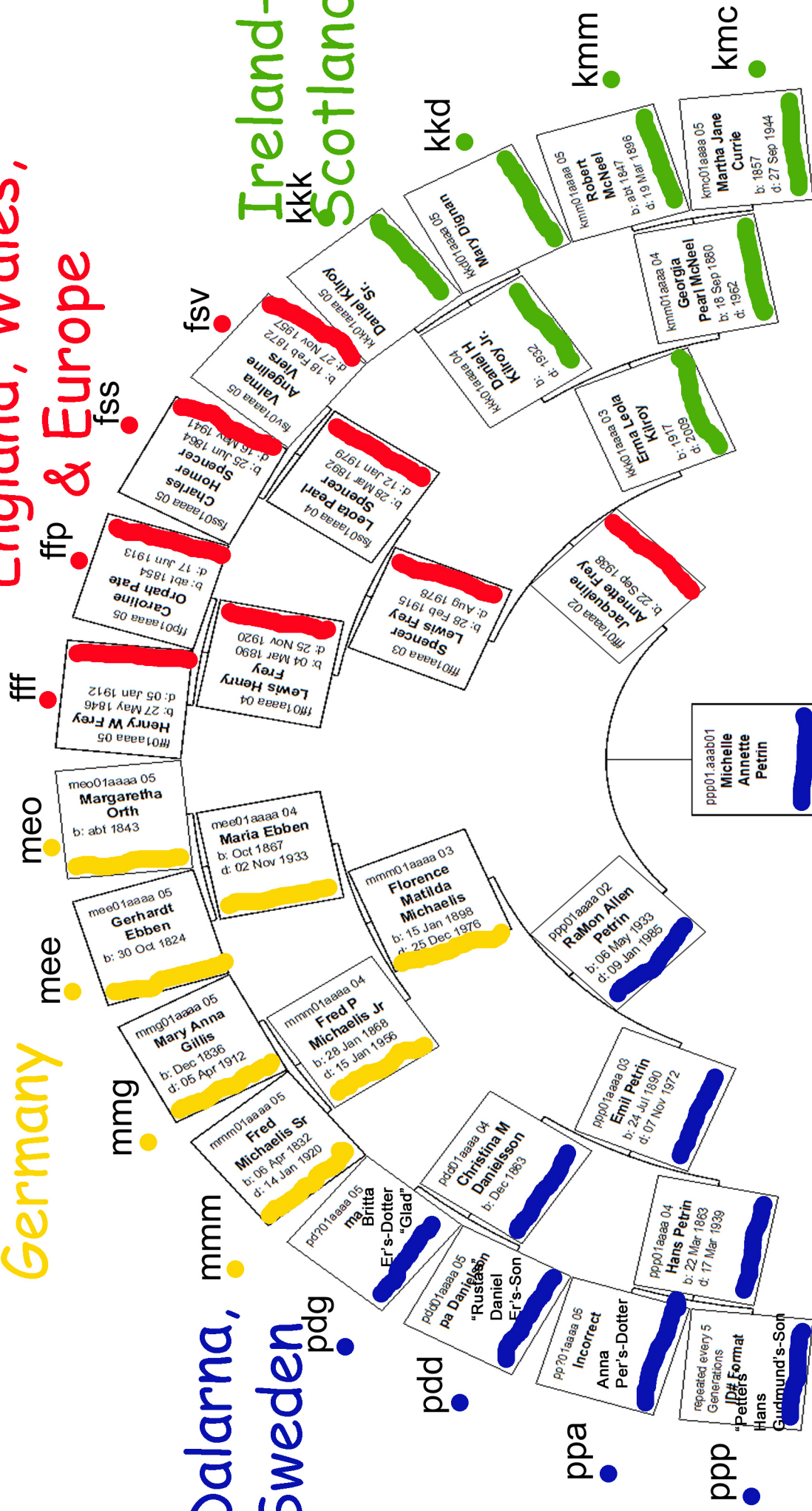
Blue= Petrin (paternal grandfather, Emil Petrin, & his ancestors)

Yellow= Michaelis (paternal grandmother, Florence Michaelis & her ancestors)

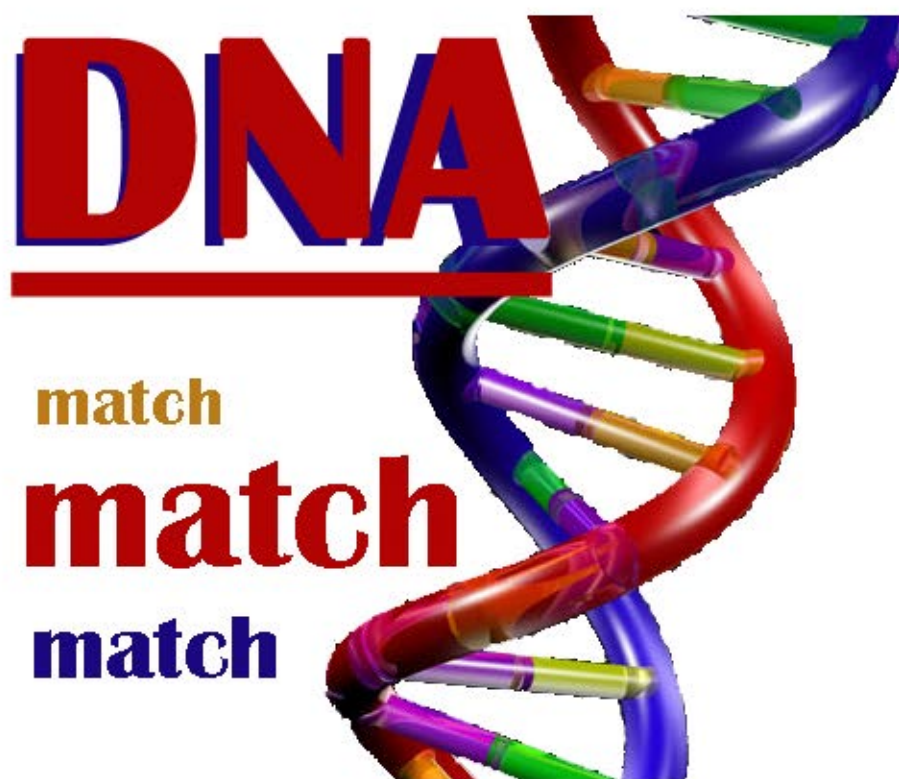
Red= Frey (maternal grandfather, Spencer Frey, & his ancestors)

DNA analysis as Guide / Confirmation in Genealogy Study

As you can see on the attached documentation, we have about 11 dna matches on the Frey/Kilroy branches. These have been tremendously helpful both as confirmation of genealogical theories and as guide for further genealogical study.

Confirmation of theory:

The two BLISS dna matches (one at 13th generation and one at 14th generation) have confirmed the theory put out by Brent Ruesch (but at odds with the Spencer Historical and Genealogical Society theory) for parentage of Spencer Frey's GG-grandfather, Jonathan William Spencer. Since Bliss surname only enters our family line if Jon's mother is Cynthia Webster (which makes sense because Jon gave his son the name Webster).

Guide for further study:

I have several Frey surname matches, but of course have been unable to determine common ancestor in order to confirm anything (since for a long time now, our Frey line has a brick wall at 1822 in Pennsylvania ... and almost all of my dna matches have been in 1600s to 1700s).

These Frey surname matches are consistently from Frey folks whose lines originate in Switzerland, then fluctuate between Germany and France before settling in Pennsylvania (where our David E. Frey was born in 1822). The Frey person who has most dna in common with my dna is Cynthia McCachern. Next is Patricia Hoyle, and then Don Beyeler. Cynthia's ancestor is Valentine Frey (1721-1798 b.France, but his grandfather and ancestors originated in Switzerland). Valentine married 1742 in PA then died 1798 in NC. Since all 3 matching Frey lines appear to lead to the same ancestors by the 1500s, I am certain this is our Frey surname source. I have a couple dna matches who show stronger dna match (with same commonalities as mine and Cynthia's) but they have not responded to email requests. If/ when they do, then I suspect we will get closer to determining who David E. Frey's ancestors are.

When relatives also submit dna sample, after 3-way analysis at the free gedMatch tools, it helps guide where to look for common ancestor. If dna from person xyz matches both myself and say Mom, Uncle Richie, or Uncle Danny, then I would look for match on Frey-Kilroy sides instead of looking at all on Petrin-Michaelis sides. Unfortunately, the reverse is not always true because some dna "snips" fall out in each generation, so it is not completely dependable that a relative will show as dna match. An example was Cathy Hernandez. We know that we have Garte (fff) in common, but we do not show as a "match" on dna. However, there are a number of folks who show with common dna to me, who also have common dna with her, so I am looking in the Frey >> Weaver >> Garte area of my tree, expecting to find our common ancestor with a surname originating from those branches.

My closest matches so far have been at 7th generation, on the McNeel branch. Finding those has really helped in guiding search, since 7th generation is so much closer to me. Then each match from there further guides by what sub-branch the dna common ancestor is found on, and whether future folks who match me match both of those (the basic branch of McNeel AND the sub-branch) or just the basic branch – because then I know to look on the OTHER sub-branches and not bother with the branch that does not match.

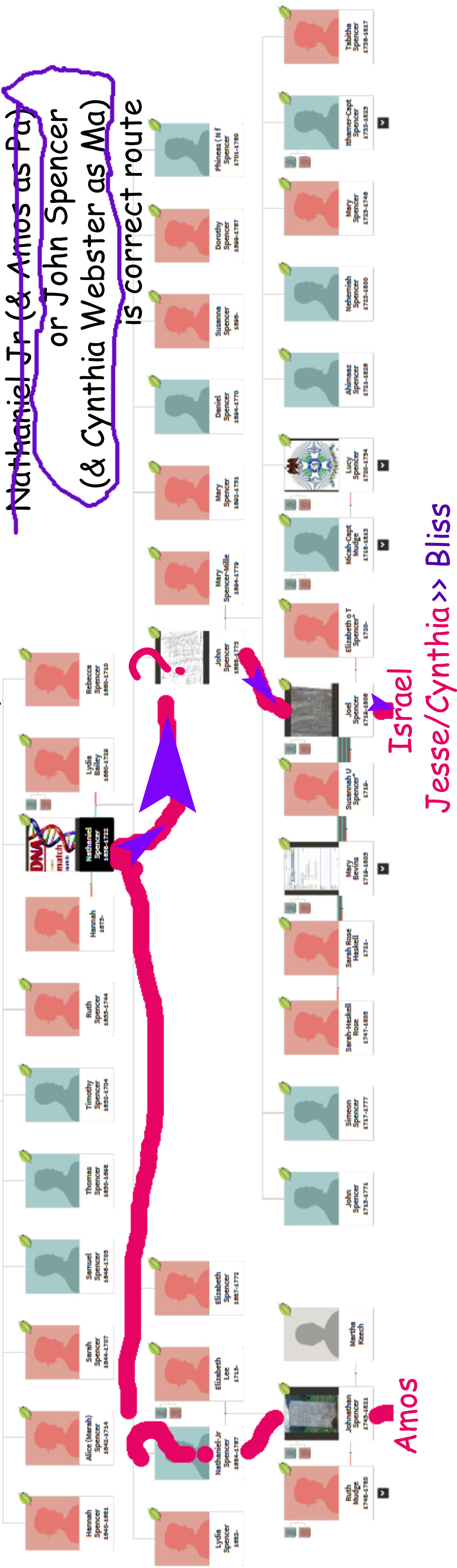
If the dna commonalities are stronger, then I look at generations closer to myself than the past match with those commonalities. If the dna commonalities are fewer, then I look at generations farther from myself. ... and that is what I suspect will tell us who David E. Frey's parents are.
